



# Notice of Availability of the Mariana Islands Training and Testing Final Supplemental EIS/OEIS

The U.S. Navy has completed a Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement/Overseas Environmental Impact Statement (EIS/OEIS) to assess the potential environmental impacts associated with ongoing training and testing activities conducted within the Mariana Islands Training and Testing (MITT) EIS/OEIS Study Area. The completion of the Final Supplemental EIS/OEIS follows years of research, analysis, stakeholder engagement, and public involvement.

## Proposed Action

The Navy is proposing to continue training and testing activities within the Study Area at sea and on Farallon de Medinilla. Proposed activities are generally consistent with previously analyzed activities and are similar to those that have occurred in the Study Area for decades.

The Proposed Action is needed to ensure the Navy, other U.S. military services, and the U.S. Coast Guard meet their respective missions, which for the Navy is to maintain, train, and equip combat-ready forces capable of winning wars, deterring aggression, and maintaining freedom of the seas.

## Public Involvement

The Navy is committed to keeping the public informed. The Navy obtained public input at several stages and held four public meetings throughout the Mariana Islands. The Final Supplemental EIS/OEIS includes responses to public comments received during the Draft Supplemental EIS/OEIS public review and comment period. In accordance with National Environmental Policy Act regulations, Navy will wait 30 days after publication of the Final Supplemental EIS/OEIS before making a final decision on the action.
